Use of Instrumentation and Monitoring Assets

Instrumentation and monitoring assets are not to be utilised as hangers for cables or any or any other purpose other than their design purpose.

The reliability and functionality of monitoring equipment plays a major part in obtaining permissions to proceed from Third Party asset owners for Crossrail work. Damaging or obscuring equipment could be detrimental to the on-going progress of the Crossrail program.

Three simple rules to remember:

- If you did not install the equipment, or are part of the contract utilising it, then do not touch or interfere with it.
- If you are asked to undertake any task on site that, you consider, may damage/obscure or remove the functionality of the instrumentStop! Report it to a supervisor/engineer or your line manager.
- If you find any instrumentation damaged on site.....Stop! Report it to a supervisor/engineer or your line manager.
